### Dressing

You will have a transparent dressing over your wound. This is to be left in place until your review appointment.

# <u>Do not under ANY circumstances remove the dressing without first consulting the breast</u> care nurse.

You may shower as normal, as the dressing is splash proof, but try to avoid getting it soaking wet as it will tend to lift off. Simply pat it dry after your shower with a soft towel.

Note: If you have any questions /concerns regarding the dressing or if the dressing starts to lift off, please contact The Breast Centre or the Breast Care Nurse for advice.

## Contact us prior to your planned review appointment if you have any of the following:

- Excessive pain not relieved by medication
- Excessive swelling in the region
- Discharge or bad odour from the wound
- Fever or chills
